- Distributed TMDL final shade deficit maps, comments and response appendix, USGS project proposal.
- Identified primary concerns addressed in comments
- Discussed process and purpose of Implementation Plan
  - Selected dates for field review to identify priority locations and locations of special interest for implementation. May 26 9:00 am at the Blacks Creek Bridge (SF Boise River). IDL will lead group on tour of Smith Creek watershed. Probably a two or three hour tour. June 25 Lime Creek tour, prepare to walk approximately 5 or 6 miles. It may take about 90 minutes to drive in to the trail-head, plan for a long day.
  - Tim will invite a representative from the South-Central IDL office on the Lime Creek tour and Susan will request that Mark Shumar join us for both tours.
- Discussed the USGS/BOR project proposal. IDL and SNF believe the project is useful for the intended purpose but may not offer much in terms of implementation for the TMDL. CH2M Hill would like to see support for the study as written. DEQ will draft a response to the proposal.
- Discussed possibilities for cooperative monitoring projects with the USGS. SNF is collecting temperature data in Lime Creek. Other projects are not apparent at this time, but FS and IDL will inform their agencies that monitoring match funds are available with the USGS.
- SNF and IDL requested a GIS layer/shape file for the TMDL maps. Susan will request those from Mark.
