10*	City of Athol	55	Coeur d'Alene	\$55,000	\$27,500	Address source and distribution system deficiencies.
11*	City of Ammon	45	Idaho Falls	\$70,000	\$35,000	Address aging system.
12*	City of Hagerman	43	Twin Falls	\$85,000	\$42,500	Address growth and changes to water system regulations.
13	City of Shoshone	35	Twin Falls	\$70,000	\$35,000	Evaluate future water demands, fireflows, source capacity and pumps, water rights, storage and distribution system.
14*	City of Kimberly	23	Twin Falls	\$60,000	\$30,000	Address growth and use of meters.
15	City of Harrison	22	Coeur d'Alene	\$30,300	\$15,150	Address capacity, possible tank leaks, aging infrastructure and meet future needs.
16	Thunder Canyon Estates Water	21	Pocatello	\$30,000	\$15,000	Address water source redundancy, standby power, and possibly develop an additional water supply.
