I am a distributor for Norweco Waste-Water Treatment Technology. I've attended DEQ's TGC meeting for ten years and in this time I've seen the TGM revise and the outcome is always the same. The manual continues to get thicker and more complicated while Idahos ground water continues to be compromised by property owners that are not maintaining their systems.

It is my opinion that the rules that are in place should be enforced. Making new rules has not been effective in protecting Idahos ground water. I agree that complex alternative septic systems should undergo minimum annual maintenance and inspection. Improper waste water treatment prior to discharge is often cause by lack of service and inspection. It is the responsibility of the property owner to ensure that its done. A limited number of service providers is not the problem.

Before initiating more rules we should enforce the rules that are already in place.
