Paula,

Please find attached some public comment for the upcoming Negotiated Rule making Docket 58-0103-1501.

Operation, maintenance, service and effluent testing that should be performed by a service operator should be clear and made publicly available to help educate home owners and accountability of service providers. Manufactures of approved systems in the State of Idaho also should be required to make publicly available the recommended maintenance and service that is in compliance and agreement with DEQ.

A public list of service providers, similar to the list of approved systems should be made available for home owners

Home owners should not be restricted from switching service providers or required to use a specific service provider under any condition

O&M Entities who have filed liens or Un-adjudicated liens against home owners in the State of Idaho should be required to remove these liens

Section 10. a. / b.

The process for removing existing easements should be made publicly available to residents of Idaho. Existing Non-Profits should be proactively required to provide written proof of releasing any easements for existing agreements
